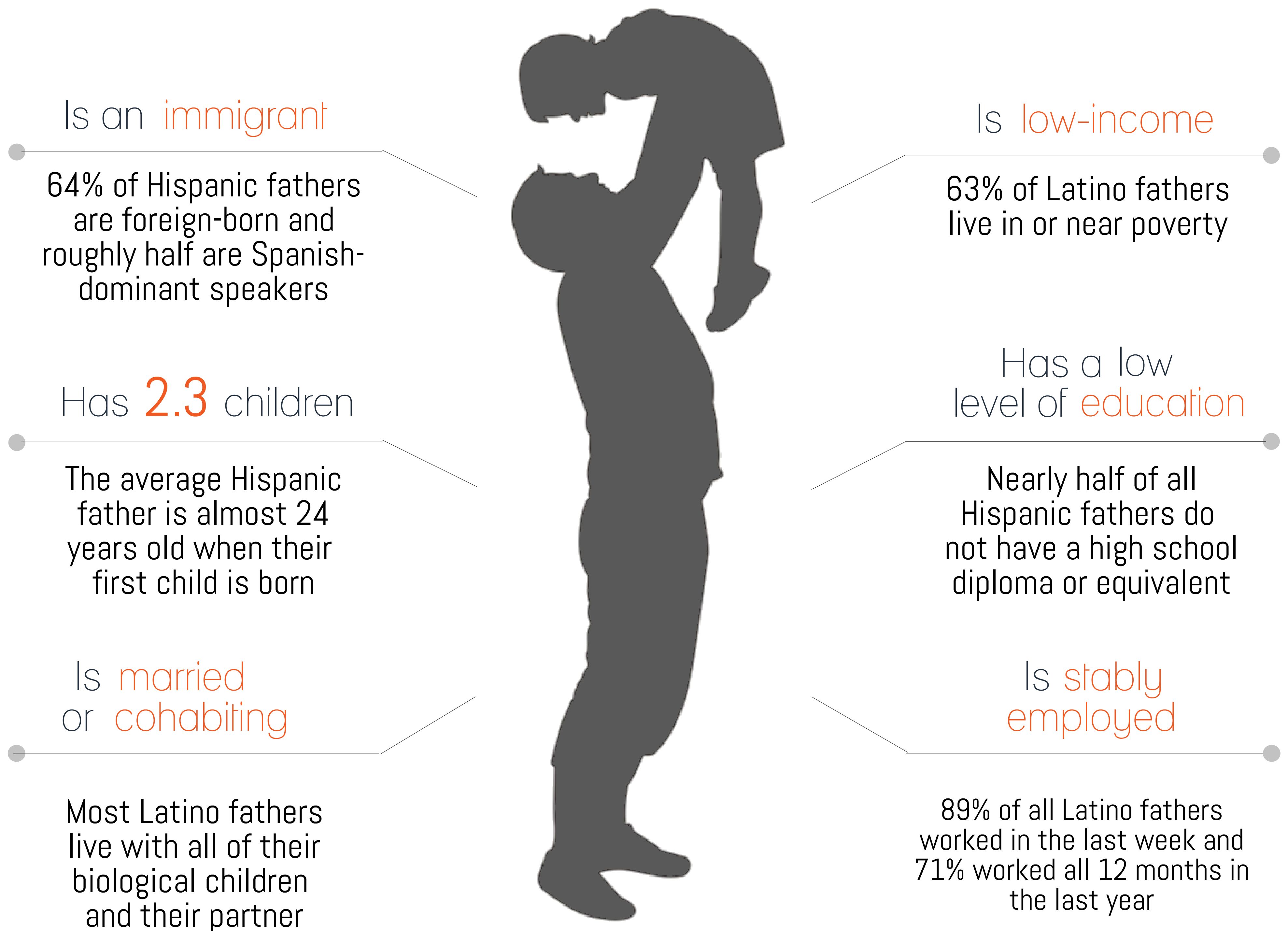


Latino Fathers in the U.S.
